The signature wine of Nyetimber is a classic blend of Chardonnay, Pinot Noir, and Pinot Meunier and is a perfect balance of elegance and intensity. The blend includes wines from all their vineyards and also from several vintages. The pale-golden hue and fine bubbles make their flagship Classic Cuvée Multi-Vintage the ideal occasion-ready drink – whether it's toasting a big birthday or simply finishing a busy week. Following extensive ageing in their cellar (usually more than three years), their Classic Cuvée Multi-Vintage has distinctive toasty and spicy aromas. A palate of honey, almond, pastry and baked apples gives it a hint of decadence. Intense yet delicate, elegant yet complex – it's no wonder it's consistently crowned one of the best English sparkling wines.

### Nyetimber Cuvée Chérie

### Nyetimber Blanc de Blancs 2014

An elegant wine of complexity and delicacy. A wine aged for a longer time on the lees to develop classic brioche and vanilla aromas. Blancs de Blancs holds a special place in the winery's heart as the first style of wine they ever produced, back in 1992. This 2013 has an enticing golden colour, tiny bubbles and delicate aromas. Aromas of fresh citrus are balanced with floral notes, and leading on to a rich pastry and brioche characters. Toasty and complex – as classic Blanc de Blancs should be.

### Tillington Single Vineyard 2013

This rare and refined wine shows the exceptional Pinot Noir character of one of their celebrated vineyards. The Tillington Single Vineyard comes in limited quantities and is only produced in specific vintages. Light gold and hints of silver with minuscule bubbles and even more beautiful to taste, its aromas encapsulate the toasted topping of crème brûlée and meringue, building into strawberry and cherry in the glass. Flavours of mandarin and pastry lead to a vanilla flavour, ensuring it is both long and balanced with an underlying power.

### **Gaja Alteni di Brassica, Langhe, Italy, 2016**

**190.00**

Powerful and nuanced, the 2016 Alteni di Brassica reaches a new level of complexity. It opens with intense spicy notes of sage, white pepper, sweet liquorice and flint. Then it evolves into its fruitier character with ripe notes of citrus, lemon peel, grapefruit, green pear and nectarine. Thanks to the bright acidity and the salinity, Alteni di Brassica 2016 retains its energy and tension, well balanced by the remarkable fruit concentration which make this wine appealing even when young. Angelo Gaja, owner and president of the Gaja Winery is a fourth-generation Piedmontese winemaker. Internationally acknowledged as one of Italy's and the world's greatest winemakers.

### **Louis Latour Corton-Charlemagne, Grand Cru, 2017**

**205.00**

From vineyards located on a prime section of the Corton hillside where the south-easterly aspect ensures maximum exposure to the sun. The fruit is harvested as late as possible to guarantee maximum ripeness. The attractive nose has minerality with ripe peaches and subtle citrus. The palate has great weight and depth. Classic Corton.

### **Caro, Bodegas Caro Rothschild Lafite, 2017**

Flagship wine from the exciting Bodegas Caro in Mendoza, a joint venture between the Rothschild's of Lafite and Nicolas Catena. The wine expresses the best of both worlds. Argentinean purity of and concentration and the expertise of the finest winemakers in France. Blueberry, violets and sandalwood with great length from the blend of old vine Malbec and Cabernet Sauvignon.

### **Maison Roche de Bellene Chambolle-Musigny Vieilles Vignes Villages, 2017**

**140.00**

The commune of Chambolle Musigny is often said to provide the most delicate wines of the Cotes de Nuits. The area is roughly square in shape with a slight lip that points south toward Beaune where a high percentage of limestone and a distinct lack of clay dominate the terroir. As a result the wines are lighter in structure with real elegance and aromatic purity. Rich nose with slightly perfumed, bright summer berry fruits. Richer, more luscious style that gives the wine a gorgeous velvety texture. Backbone of blackcurrants and damson with plenty of freshness and vibrancy. Generous, slightly savoury, long autumn berry finish with fine tannins. Impressive and well crafted

### **Chateau Batailley, Pauillac, 2015**

**145.00**

This Classified 5th Growth produces some of the most reliable Pauillac available. A bouquet of smoky blackberry, blueberry and cedar. The palate is full of energy, delivering classic dark fruit, spice and tobacco notes toward the persistent finish.

### **Vieux Telegraphe, Chateauneuf-du-Pape Rouge, 2017**

**150.00**

A classic and traditional estate run by the Brunier family, currently sixth generation. The Vieux Telegraphe is from the prime lieu-dit of La Crau and is an elegant, floral example. Ruby in colour with notes of red currants, peppery garrigue and excellent minerality. This leads to a medium to full bodied and sleek wine, full of ripe raspberries and spice with wonderful structure and balance.

### **Bodegas Catena, Nicolas Catena Zapata, 2016**

**160.00**

Bodega Catena Zapata and Nicolás Catena have both been instrumental in the development of fine wine production in Argentina. The first vintage of this Cabernet Sauvignon and Malbec blend set a new standard of quality for wines from South America in 1997, winning a series of blind tastings against other prestigious wines from around the world. This is rich and flavourful with blackcurrant and tobacco. Full-bodied yet soft and fruity with bright and spicy minerality and fresh-herb complexity.

### **Bibi Graetz Testamatta Tuscany IGP, 2015**

**210.00**

100% Sangiovese in its purest form from one of Italy's cult winemakers; Bibi Graetz. Dark and deep in colour with aromas of wild berries and jasmine on the nose. The palate provides an abundance of more dark fruit, leather and spice with just a touch of dark chocolate on the finish.

### **Gaja Barbaresco DOCG, Piedmont, Italy, 2016**

**270.00**

Clean and expressive, it opens with pure floral notes of rose petal and elderflowers. Warm spices like black pepper and tobacco give roundness to the bouquet. The palate features a remarkably sweet fruit concentration, with juicy and sweet red and black fruit, such as red cherry, plum, blueberry. The exuberance of the fruit and floral expression is temperate by the good acidity and the silky tannins.
