Early developing Claret. A core of fresh and crunchy blackcurrant with a soothing and harmonious tannin structure. Gravel and underlying cedar touch on the finish.

Enticing aroma of both red and black fruits with underlying vanilla and tobacco tones. Full, rich and round palate with impressive elegance, thanks to the silky-smooth tannins and black fruits, roasted coffee and dark chocolate.

Jumilla is one of the most underrated areas in Spain, and this richly structured, generous and jammy red shows both appeal and a wonderful complexity - with similarities between a top Bordeaux and Rhône blended with a good Rioja

Col di Sasso means "Stony Hill" referencing the soils where the vineyards lie in Southern Tuscany. Like a "Baby Super Tuscan" the Cabernet Sauvignon imparts both flavour and body, the Sangiovese provides structure and intense fruit.	

342. Nero D'Avola, Santa Tresa, Sicily	36.00
Fresh and unoaked, this soft, supple wine is made in a modern style. Elegant plum and dark berry fruit with fantastic purity make this dangerously easy to drink.	

343. Barolo Reverdito, DOCG, Piedmont, 2018	70.00
Charming notes of dried strawberry, cherry, violet and leather. Silky on the palate with some farmyard characteristics. Prune and ripe cherry offer good fruit purity and freshness. Impressive tannin structure and lingering mature finish.	

344. Amarone Della Valpolicella "Negar" DOCG, Veneto, 2020	73.00
Blend of Corvina, Corvinone and Rondinella. Classic drying process in large "Fruittaio" after the harvest. Dense and compact. Fruit notes of cherry and dried fruits soaked in spirits, delivering a firm softness with velvety tannins	

345. Valpolicella Ripasso, Giuseppe Lonardi, 2021, Italy	95.00
Rich, full bodied wine with layers of complexity featuring notes of cherry, chocolate, spice and blackberry. Sumptuous and smooth on the finish.	

Lebanon

375. Chateau Musar, Gaston Hochar, 2017, Lebanon	88.00
Gaston Hochar was only 20 years old when, in 1930, he founded Chateau Musar. Inspired by Lebanon's 6000 years of wine making tradition, impressive aromas of mixed autumn berries, wonderfully soft palate with chocolaty notes in the background, compelling structure and impressive elegance all the way to the end	

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Romania

350. Feteasca Neagra, Solevari, 2021, Romania	39.50
A wonderfully spicy aroma of freshly cracked black pepper, blackberry and blackcurrant. Reminiscent of Pinot Noir, medium bodied with fine tannins and a beautifully balanced acidity.	
351. Bats Blood Merlot, Cramele Macas, Banat, Romania -	35.00
A rich inviting red that balances fruit, spice and elegance. 100% Merlot aged in French Oak, it reveals vibrant notes of spiced plums, toffee and a touch of pepper to give this wine some bite!	

Armenia

352. Takar Areni Red, 2021, Aragotsotn, Armenia	55.00
A medium bodied red from the native Areni grape. Dark fruits of blackberries, cherries with a hint of smoke overlap to create a smooth finish. A background minerality provides a great balance to this wine.	

Moldova

353. Chateau Purcari, Rara Neagra, Moldova	55.00
Beautifully balanced dry red wine. Combination of indigenous Rara Neagra and the robust Saperavi – this wine is both elegant and expressive. Plush aromas of dark berries and soft spices on the nose

A vibrant, dry red wine that showcases the countries Saperavi grape., Deep ruby colour with aromas of ripe cherries, black plum and forest fruits

Gorgeous black cherry and plums fused with pepper, oak and hints of mocha. Multi-layered texture with a lovely purity and a smooth black fruit finish, dotted with violets and spice.

South Africa

370. Merlot, Franschhoek Cellar, Western Cape, South Africa 9.00 12.00 32.00
Lashings of liberal ripe plum, red cherries and fruitcake spice that extend to a juicy, supple palate with velvet tannins and sensitive well-integrated oak.

371. Pinot Noir, Hamilton Russell, Hamel-En-Aarde Valley, 2021, South Africa 84.00
This Pinot Noir is considered "South Africa's Best". Never compromises on flavour, structure, bouquet and complexity. Not overly fruity, soft and "sweet" dark, spicy, complex character. Blind tasted, suggests a mega expensive "Burgundy".

USA

381. Pinot Noir, "The Crusher" Clarksburg, California, USA 48.00
Smouldering away with inviting aromas of wild berries, raspberry and cedar that combine with flavours of cherry and cranberry on a silky textured palate, finishing long and mellow with some sweet spice.

382. Messina Hof Private Reserve Malbec, Texas, USA 96.00
Unique wine to be seen in the UK market. A marriage between generations of families from Messina (Italy) and Hof (Germany). Grapes ripened under intense heat bringing out hints of black plum, currant and spice. Barrel aging gives robust tannins and smooth mouthfeel.

Mexico

383. Petite Sirah, L.A. Cetto, 2019, Baja California, Mexico 36.00
A deep ruby coloured wine. Rich, rustic and plenty of berry flavours abound in this lesser found grape variety.

384. Tannat, Altos de Jose Ignacio, Uruguay 40.00
A juicy wine with fresh aromas of plums, raspberries and spices. It has silky soft tannins to complement the blackberry and oak flavours on the palate.

Chile

390. Carmenere Reserva, Lorosco, Colchagua Valley, Chile 6.40 8.85 32.00
Classic nose of autumn hedgerow and bramble fruits. Bright and vibrant palate with impressive purity of blackberry underpinned by mocha and black pepper spice.

391. Cabernet Sauvignon, Lorosco, Colchagua Valley, Chile 6.40 8.85 32.00
Intense fruity aromas of blackberries and plums. This wine has a full body with a soft mouthfeel. Background aromas of vanilla and spices are present.

Argentina

395. Malbec Classico, Kaiken, Mendoza, Argentina 36.00
Rich, dark and full-bodied with mature black forest fruits and a hint of spice, married to soft vanilla flavours as a result of ageing in French oak.

396. Bodegas Catena, Nicolas Catena Zapata, 2016, Argentina 94.00
